

Your school wants to support you. You are not alone.

As a student survivor of sexual assault, you are protected under federal Title IX legislation; this means your school must work to make you feel supported and safe. Supports can include: changing campus housing or class schedules with no financial impact, working with professors for flexibility in your academic commitments, providing campus escorts for your safety, restricting the assailant from contacting you, and more.

The table below details resources at your school where you can:

- Receive support and discuss your options via counseling services or staff trained in these sensitive matters.
- Report the incident to the Title IX Coordinator or campus police/public safety. If you do not want to involve police, your school can still investigate the matter (potentially leading to campus disciplinary action for your assailant).
